Minutes of the Ordinary Meeting of Melbourne Parish Council held at 7.30pm 16th July 2013 at the Shone Lounge Room, Melbourne Assembly Rooms, High Street, Melbourne

497. Public Conveniences

The Parish Council has received a letter from SDDC, dated 8th July 2013, consulting it on a proposal for SDDC to sell and demolish the public conveniences on the High Street, Melbourne.

The Parish Council discussed the proposal and agreed that there is a need for public conveniences within Melbourne. This need is based on the level of tourism, provision for local businesses whom do not have their own facilities, plus the current facilities are substantially used.

A lengthy discussion took place as to whether the proposal to relocate the toilets to the Assembly Room was the best solution, but no decision was reached; however, it was agreed that the Assembly Rooms could be a possible solution if the public conveniences were demolished.

The Clerk will send a letter advising SDDC of the Parish Council's decision above.
